



ZIKA INFORMATION UPDATE As of January 2017

As the #1 travel destination in the US, safety is the top priority for our region. We have an extraordinary infrastructure of public and private entities working together to protect the health and safety of our residents and visitors. The region benefits from multiple layers of proactive education and prevention efforts including robust programs of Orange County's mosquito control department as well as highly maintained landscaping efforts from our many tourism partners. We communicate regularly with numerous state and local public health organizations, such as the Florida Department of Health, to monitor new developments.

No locally-acquired cases of Zika have been reported in our region and no travel advisories for the US, and we have every confidence in our county's public health system and its ability to manage any developments swiftly and effectively.
